Public Four-Year Dashboard History

- National Governor's Association: "Complete to Compete" (2010)
- Legislatively endorsed in 2011
- Close collaboration between the Education Research and Data Center, Department of Enterprise Services (DES), and the six public baccalaureates
- First version unveiled in December 2011
- Updated yearly
- Accomplished with no state funding! (Funded by a 2009 American Recovery and Reinvestment Act grant)

Washington: A National Leader

■ Dashboard advantages include:

- Standardized calculations and the display of metrics
- Expanded data availability
- Higher quality policy research
- Increased dialogue between educators, researchers, and policymakers
- Improved public understanding of higher education performance

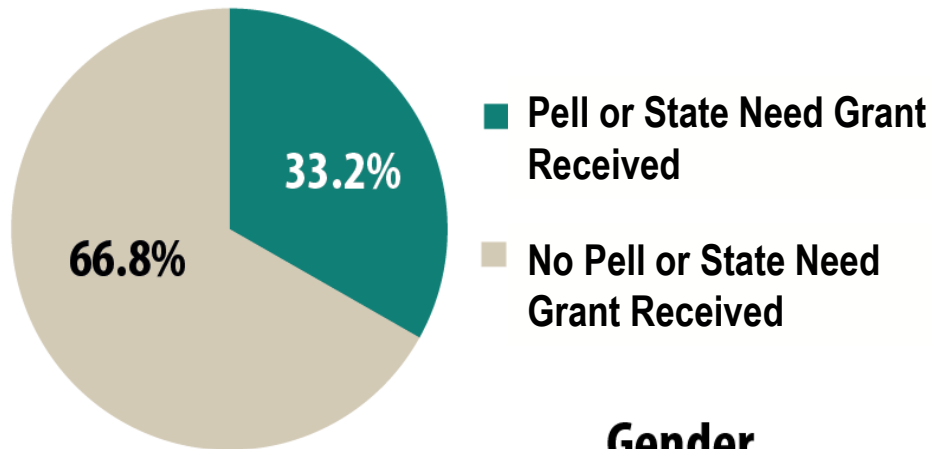

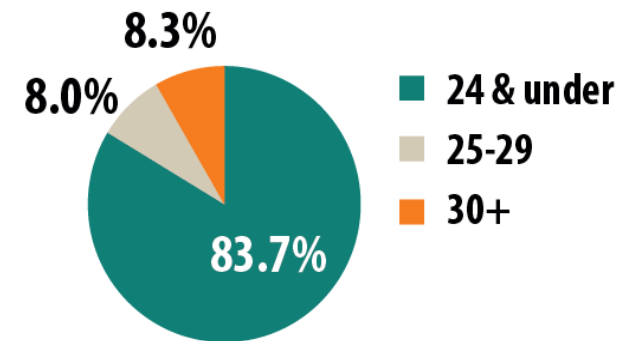
Undergraduate Student Profile (2014-2015)

- **37%** of degrees awarded in STEM/High Demand areas

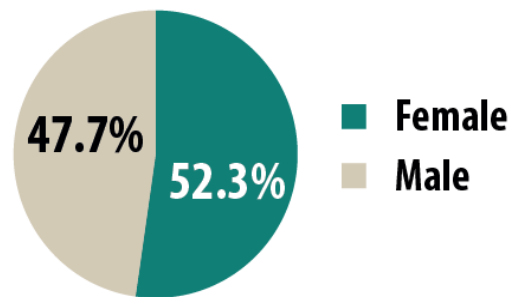
Pell or State Need Grant Status



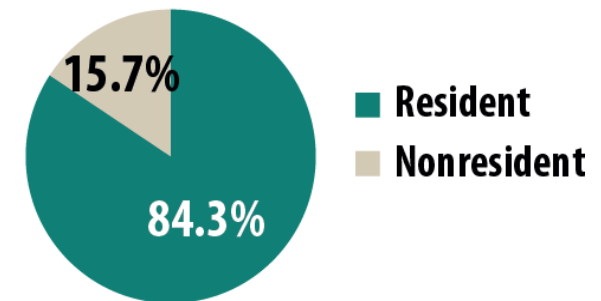
