Annual average state-funded FTE student enrollments are calculated by dividing the sum of state-funded term FTEs at quarter-system institutions by three and by dividing the sum of state-funded term FTEs at semester-system institutions by two.

²Baccalaureate programs offered at Bellevue College, Columbia Basin Community College, Lake Washington Technical College, Olympic College, Peninsula College, South Seattle Community College, and Seattle Community College.

³ FTEs for these programs are included in the SBCTC's budget and reported by the four-year institution. Includes 40 FTEs allocated to Peninsula and Olympic Colleges.
